The doctor's internship in internal medicine was completed at the Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center in New Orleans, Louisiana. He then moved to Austin, Texas, and completed his residency in dermatology at the University of Texas at Austin Dell Medical School, where he served as Chief Resident during his final year.

An authority in his field, he is board-certified in dermatology by the American Board of Dermatology, which is a voluntary, non-profit, private, autonomous organization formed for the primary purpose of protecting the public interest by establishing and maintaining high standards of training, education, and qualifications of physicians rendering care in dermatology.

Although he thoroughly enjoys seeing patients of all ages, Dr. Green has a special passion for dermatologic conditions afflicting the geriatric population and was the co-founder of the Geriatric Interest Group in medical school. He hopes to expand upon this passion throughout his career by continuing to stay up-to-date with the latest research and treatment options for patients of all ages.

Published in both the Journal of the American Academy of Dermatology and the Pediatric Dermatology Journal, he has also presented many posters on various dermatologic conditions at statewide meetings.
