Many doctors now refer to hair removal by laser treatment as long-term hair removal rather than a permanent method of hair reduction.

What is the procedure for laser hair removal?

The pigment in individual hairs is targeted by laser light for elimination via laser hair removal. As the light crosses through the hair follicle, it is absorbed by the hair shaft.

The laser light heats the hair follicle, destroying it and making it impossible for hair to grow from it.

Hair goes through a distinct development cycle, including rest, shedding, and growth. Because the technician or laser will not see newly removed hair that is in its resting phase, the patient may have to wait until it comes back before having it removed.

Laser [hair removal treatment in Gurgaon](#) usually necessitates a series of sessions spaced out over two to three months.

How Do I Get Long-Lasting Results?

Semi-permanent outcomes can be achieved. Your treatments should have a long-term impact, at least a couple of years. However, expecting your follicles to never recover from the thermal damage they sustained isn't very practical. A treatment's durability is influenced by the site where it was performed. Arms, legs, and the pubic area are where undesirable hair grows thicker and lasts longer than other parts of our bodies, such as the face, neck, and chest. Your skin's health is also a factor in the treatment's longevity.

Is there a time limit on the effectiveness of laser hair removal?

When the hair follicle is destroyed, laser hair removal is long-lasting. If only the hair follicle is destroyed, hair will come back.

Individual hair development cycles dictate how long it takes to regrow. Some people have it faster than others when it comes to hair growth. Slower growth is associated with hair that is in the process of going into resting mode.

Some hair regrowth can be expected within a few months for most people. Then they can decide whether or not they want to have additional treatments.

Risks and complications

Treatment can cause some people to suffer from burning, stinging, and pain. Because of this, many technicians in **Gurgaon** use a numbing cream to numb the region they're working with. Some persons may have a skin reaction or allergy to the numbing cream.

Several minor side effects might occur, like as

- The appearance of a darker skin tone, especially in those with darker skin
- A rosy flush to the skin
- Crusting, blistering, or peeling of skin

Hair removal-induced dermatitis and subsequent scarring are also possible outcomes. Infected wounds can spread to other parts of the body. Skin infections can progress and become life-threatening, even though extremely rare.

An accurate medical history and a discussion of risks and benefits can help doctors identify which treatments are most effective, lowering the likelihood of significant side effects.

A person should avoid the sun after having their hair removed. Blisters and scars are more likely to form when exposed to the sun's ultraviolet (UV) rays.

People who are experiencing severe discomfort, a fever, crusting, blisters, or other symptoms of skin injury or infection should seek immediate medical assistance."

Hair may regrow following laser hair removal, but it is still worth the time and effort spent in the beginning. Unwanted hair removal should be easy and painless, with results lasting for years.
