She successfully completed her internship in internal medicine at Harvard's Mount Auburn Hospital in Boston, Massachusetts in 1998, and then graduated residency at Harvard Joint Center for Radiation Therapy in 2002.

With years of experience, the doctor is board-certified in radiation oncology by the American Board of Radiology (ABR). The mission of the ABR is to serve patients, the public, and the medical profession by certifying that its diplomates have acquired, demonstrated, and maintained a requisite standard of knowledge, skill, and understanding essential to the safe and competent practice of diagnostic radiology, radiation oncology, and medical physics.

Throughout her line of work, Dr. Sha has served in various leadership positions including Service Chief of Radiation Oncology at Lakeland Regional Medical Center, Board Member of the American Cancer Society West Polk Unit, Board Member of the American Cancer Society East Polk Unit, Board Member of the Central Florida Cancer Institute Foundation, and Medical Advisor for the American Cancer Society. She has also served as Event Chair for Making Strides Against Breast Cancer.

Practicing medicine in Florida, she is affiliated with AdventHealth Heart of Florida, Lakeland Regional Health Medical Center, AdventHealth Lake Wales, James A. Haley Veterans' Hospital-Tampa, and Watson Clinic Cancer & Research Center.

Continuously advancing her efforts, she is an active member of the American Society for Therapeutic Radiation Oncology, the American College of Radiology, and the American Society of Clinical Oncology.

Radiation oncology is a medical specialty that involves the controlled use of radiation to treat cancer. It is one of the three primary specialties – the other two being surgical and medical oncology – involved in the treatment of cancer. A radiation oncologist is a specialist physician who uses ionizing radiation in the treatment of cancer.

Relating to her work in breast cancer. Dr. Sha has been involved in a number of research projects, presentations, and peer-reviewed publications, including her breast cancer work at the San Antonio Breast Conference in 2010, presentation at the American Brachytherapy Society in San Diego in 2011, publication in the Red Journal in 2012, presentation at the ABS/ESTRO World Congress Brachytherapy meeting in Barcelona, Spain in 2012, and presentation at the annual American Brachytherapy Society meeting in 2013. Her work on Mammogram Impact on Survival of Elderly Breast Cancer Patients was presented at the American Society of Breast Surgeons in Orlando in 2015.

As a testament to her dedication to excellence, Dr. Sha has been honored as a Distinguished Physician by the Florida Medical Association two years in a row, won the "Leading Physicians of the World" award in 2013, was honored with the "Most Compassionate Physician award in 2012, won the Patient's Choice Award in 2011, won the "Top Oncologist in Florida Award" in 2014, as well as won "Most Compassionate Doctor Award" five years in a row, ending in 2015.

Frequently featured as the keynote speaker in a variety of large events, she has also been featured on ABC News, ABC Action News, and PG TV programming.
