He served as an orthopedic surgeon with the US Marines at Camp Lejeune, overseas at the US Naval Hospital Guam, at US Naval Hospital Portsmouth, and aboard the hospital ship USNS Comfort during wartime.

Finally, Dr. Headrick completed advanced studies in reconstructive joint replacement surgery as an Otto E. Aufranc Fellow at the highly acclaimed New England Baptist Hospital. The yearlong fellowship included state-of-the-art early intervention techniques for arthritis in association with Harvard Medical School and Brigham and Women's Hospital. He utilizes the latest technology with regard to surgical techniques and implants.

As a testament to his continued education, the doctor is board-certified in orthopedic surgery and sports medicine by the American Board of Orthopedic Surgery (ABOS). The ABOS is an organization with the goal of establishing educational and professional standards for orthopedic residents and surgeons as well as evaluating the qualifications and competence of orthopedic surgeons.

Orthopedic surgery is the branch of surgery concerned with conditions involving the musculoskeletal system. Orthopedic surgeons use both surgical and non-surgical means to treat musculoskeletal trauma, spine diseases, sports injuries, degenerative diseases, infections, tumors, and congenital disorders.
