He also worked at Johns Hopkins University and the University of California, San Diego as a clinical instructor.

With a special passion for caring for student-athletes, Dr. Battaglia donates his time as the team physician for the Issaquah High School football team. While at the Naval Academy he gained experience operating on a vast number of Division IA NCAA athletes.

Proud of his military service, he is a retired Navy Captain (O-6) in the United States Navy and he has cared for and operated on US Navy SEALS, Force Recon Marines, and the men and women serving in the Navy/Marine Corps. He was the chief orthopedic consultant for the SEAL teams on the west coast.
