
BJS' Smart Girl Team Conducts Virtual Webinar on Break the Bias from Self to Society, IWD Celebration

It aims to help them to become more resilient in the face of crisis and in the rebuilding of their societies.

To celebrate the spirit and success of women, a special virtual webinar was held by the BJS Smart Girl team on the occasion of International Women's Day 2022. The theme this year revolved around Breaking the Bias. In line with the global theme, the topic of the virtual webinar was Break the Bias - from self to society.

On this special occasion, four successful women were invited to the webinar as special guests.
