It is our responsibility to not sit back and observe as silent spectators and take whatever steps we can to improve the situation for the people of Ukraine.

One reason for choosing this style of NFTs is to create awareness for the people around the world. It is extremely important for people to understand what is happening on the ground and raise their voice in the international communities to ensure a safe and peaceful resolution to the current situation. The BAD Putin NFT project could become a major driving force towards that conclusion with its unique approach and support from people investing in NFTs right now.

Of course, a project like this tends to grow beyond a singular objective and the creators of BAD Putin have vowed to create a community that can continue the humanitarian work post war. Future projects are also expected to stem out from the success of BAD Putin's NFT launch and sale. The success of this venture is obviously dependent entirely on the willingness of people to participate. According to the experts, the image that this war has had is so big that it could quickly turn into the largest humanitarian crisis that Europe has ever faced since the 90s!

The figures quoted by UNHCR, the refugee division of the United Nations, amount to a massive 10 million+ by now! According to them, the seven million figure is only for internally displaced persons (IDPs). The people who have already moved to neighboring countries also amount to nearly four million. Of course, we cannot overlook the loss of lives and injuries caused to civilians, with nearly a thousand civilians dead and close to 1500 injured.

It is devastating to see how the Russian forces have decided to attack densely populated civilian areas after facing defeat on several fronts from the Ukrainian military and volunteer fighters from home and

abroad. The impact of COVID-19 can also not be ignored as only 36% of Ukraine's population is currently vaccinated. The impact of this war has also put tremendous strain on the country's healthcare system, especially with the Russian air force targeting hospitals.

By providing support directly to the Ukraine government, BAD Putin is a great initiative for support. The creators of the project have worked day and night to bring this project to life in the shortest possible time. That alone is a feat worth praising, yet the platform aims to make it worth your while. With plans for giveaways, NFT surprises, and multiple special announcements planned in the coming days and months, it could easily be a viral platform with substantial growth from an investment perspective.

Being a humanitarian project, BAD Putin is also avoiding any stealth launches and will make its collection available to the public directly on launch date. The project is expected to launch by the end of April and is going to be available on the OpenSea marketplace. The purchasing process is also shown on the project's official website (https://badputin.io) along with other useful information. To keep potential buyers and interested parties informed, the creators have also set up a Twitter account and a Discord channel.
