- You can add your own vector or raster pictures by dragging and dropping 14 shapes to which you can add colours, gradients, and patterns.
- Inside of shapes to colour
- Google's typeface library contains over 800 fonts. Fill and outline choices for typefaces with colours, gradients, and patterns are available.
