
Alexandra Vino's Film 'Green Kola' to Debut at Paris Indie Film Festival

Alexandra Vino is no stranger to the screen, big or small. Ever since she was a teenager, she has been a successful commercial actress in Manhattan, landing more than twenty ads. Badmaa\$h Company director Parmeet Sethi hired Alexandra as Linda, the lead role, to dance with Shahid Kapoor and Anushka Sharma, and her professional acting career took off from there. She also proudly studied for ten years at New York City's famed Actor's Studio and is a lifelong member.

Alexandra played organized crime victim Gloria Wisnewski alongside Mark Wahlberg in Peter Berg's Spenser Confidential. In addition, she co-starred with Joanne Whalley, Jim Caviezel, and Olivier Martinez in Paul, the Apostle of Christ, directed by Andrew Hyatt.

Following her portrayal as Gina Gershon's secretary, Lindsay, on HBO's How to Make it in America, Alexandra Vino appeared in recurring parts on CBS's Golden Boy and Marvel's Agent Carter.

In addition to being an outstanding actress, Alexandra Vino is also a philanthropist. Many of her art pieces have been auctioned off in support of <u>Stop Poaching Now</u>, a charity close to her heart.
