Despite these setbacks, The Golden Age foundation remained determined to provide safe and reliable transportation for its members. For years, philanthropy and giving back to the community have been a staple in Mr. Pelgrim's life in St. Maarten, so teaming up with The Golden Age Foundation was an easy decision.
