If the truck guardians had a valid reason and if the IRS accepted the late payment, then there may be a chance to avoid a penalty.

If truck owners file and pay [Heavy Vehicle Use Tax](#) by the IRS Form 2290 Due Date, they must generally pay the original 2290 Tax to the IRS. If truckers do not pay their HVUT on time, they will be charged a penalty in addition to the initial 2290 tax. In addition to the monthly 2290 tax payment, truck owners may be assessed a 0.5 percent penalty. Truck guardians must pay a 0.5 percent penalty in addition to the HVUT for five months after the IRS Form 2290 due date.
