He completed his internship and residency in neurosurgery at the Cleveland Clinic in 1990, followed by a fellowship in microneurosurgery at Presbyterian University Hospital in 1991.

As a testament to his continued education, the doctor is board-certified in neurosurgery by the American Board of Neurological Surgery (ABNS). The broad aim of the ABNS is to encourage the study, improve the practice, elevate the standards and advance the science of neurological surgery and thereby serving the cause of public health.

Achieving fellowship status, Dr. Larkins is a Fellow of the American College of Surgeons (FACS), and a Fellow of the American Academy of Neurological Surgeons (FAANS).

On a professional level, he is an active member of the American Medical Association, the Congress of Neurological Surgeons, the Eastern Association of Surgery of Trauma, and the American Association of the Surgery of Trauma.

In his local area, Dr. Larkins is affiliated with Regions Hospital, Abbott Northwestern Hospital, and North Memorial Hospital.

As for his academic appointments, he serves as faculty at the University of North Dakota, and is a Clinical Instructor at the University of California-Davis, and Wright State University.

Neurosurgery is the medical specialty concerned with the prevention, diagnosis, surgical treatment, and rehabilitation of disorders that affect any portion of the nervous system including the brain, spinal cord, peripheral nerves, and extra-cranial cerebrovascular system. Neurosurgeons are doctors who diagnose and treat problems with the nervous system, often by performing surgery on the brain or spine. They treat strokes, tumors, cervical and lumbar disc disease, infections, and head or spinal cord injuries.
