The team, led by Founder and CEO Nick Devane and Design Director Gabriel Wartofsky, undertook a radical rethinking of the future of camping. Carpenters, designers, metalworkers, engineers, machinists, and mechanics all assisted with the concept and fully functioning prototypes. Designed and refined throughout the build process, this camper embodies the old ways of fabrication, animated by the latest technology available.
