Plan In Advance

Make sure you are planning everything in advance. For instance, you should start looking for an international shipping company at least two to three months prior to your move. Delaying will leave you with two choices - you will either have to fly your stuff at a very high price or your stuff will arrive several weeks late. Choosing Between Ocean And Air Freight

Compared to air freight, ocean freight is cheaper because the global sea freight industry has massive overcapacity. Air freight is expensive because it is faster. For instance, a ship will take approximately 20-30 days in travelling from one country to another but an airplane will cover the same distance in maybe three hours maximum. Also, air freight's carbon footprint is higher compared to a ship.

Getting Quotations From Shipping Companies

It is very important to compare shipping quotes before you make a final decision. International shipping of goods can be expensive so you need to be well prepared. Since there are multiple shipping companies in the market, you will have to make a calculated choice.

Getting Your Flight Ticket

It is recommended to book your flight ticket in advance. If it is a short-haul flight, buy your tickets at least seven weeks in advance whereas for long-haul flights, book tickets at least eighteen weeks in advance.

Sell The Stuff You Don't Need

The less you bring, the cheaper your ocean freight charges will be. It is better to cut the fat and sell off items you don't need. This needs to be done before your items start loading up and shipping out. Being smart will help you spend significantly less money. It is better to take only half the stuff when moving to a new country.

Last but not the least, you need to choose between FCL and LCL. FCL is full container load and LCL is less than container load. If you choose FCL, you will be paying a flat rate for the full use of the container that is available in 40 and 20 feet. LCL means you will be sharing the container with other people. This is significantly cheaper compared to FCL.

In the case of an FCL, the container will be delivered from one door to another whereas, in the case of an LCL, the shipment has to be put together carefully in a warehouse before it gets shipped. It is then uploaded to the destination port. When you hire a professional shipping company, they will take care of all your shipping needs.
