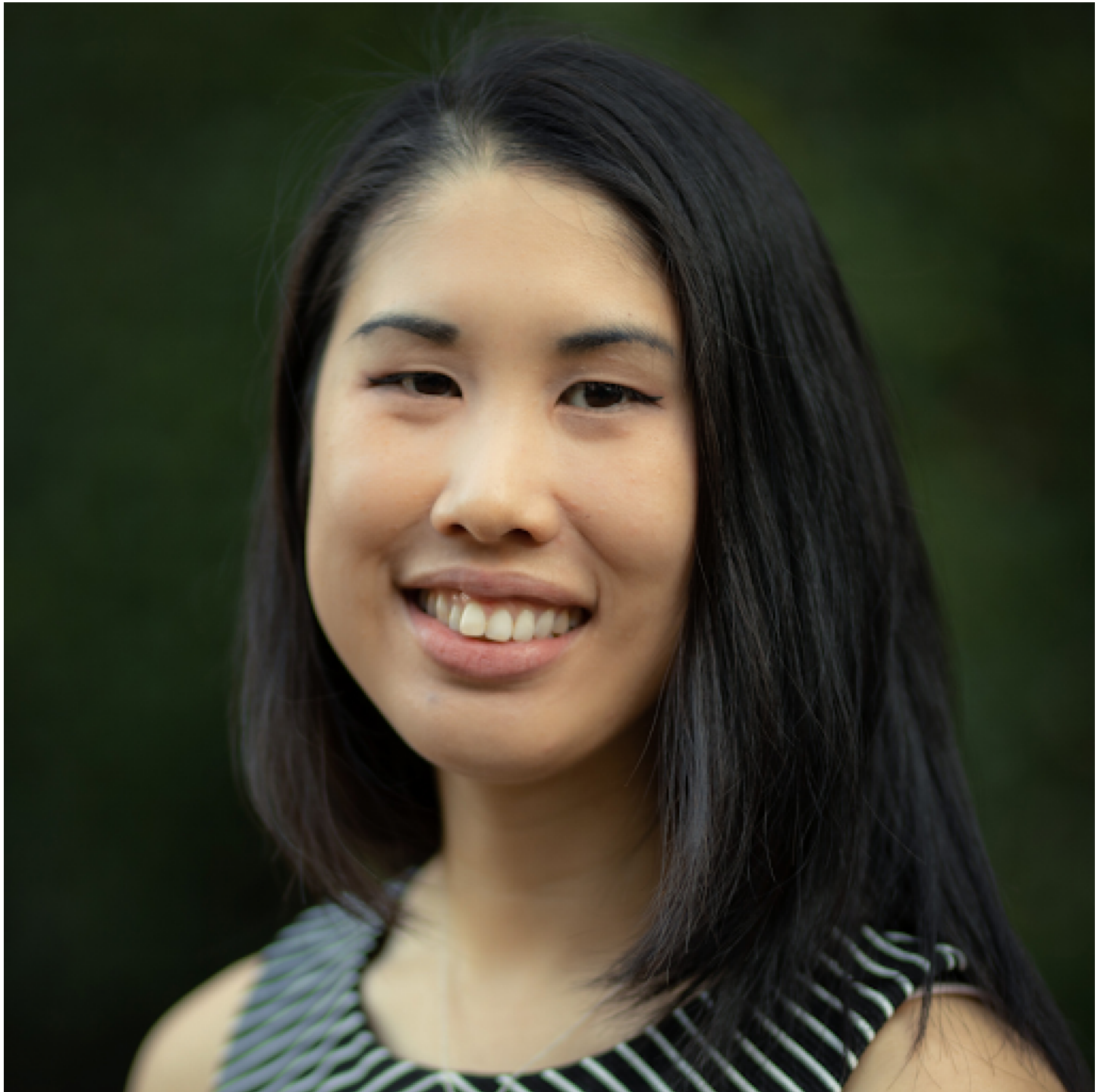


Cynthia Kwong, MD, a General Surgeon with North Texas Surgery

Holding membership status, she is an active member of the American College of Surgeons, the American Medical Association, the Association of Women Surgeons, and the Eastern Association for the Surgery of Trauma.

General surgery is a surgical specialty that focuses on abdominal contents including the esophagus, stomach, small bowel, colon, liver, pancreas, gallbladder, appendix and bile ducts, and often the thyroid gland. A general surgeon performs a wide range of abdominal surgeries for many forms of intestinal and abdominal wall neoplasms, gallbladder disease, and gastric and pancreatic disease. They follow the patient through critical care and surgical recovery all the way to outpatient care.

Among her most notable achievements, Dr. Kwong was the recipient of the Resident of the Year Award at Kings County Hospital Center in 2018.
