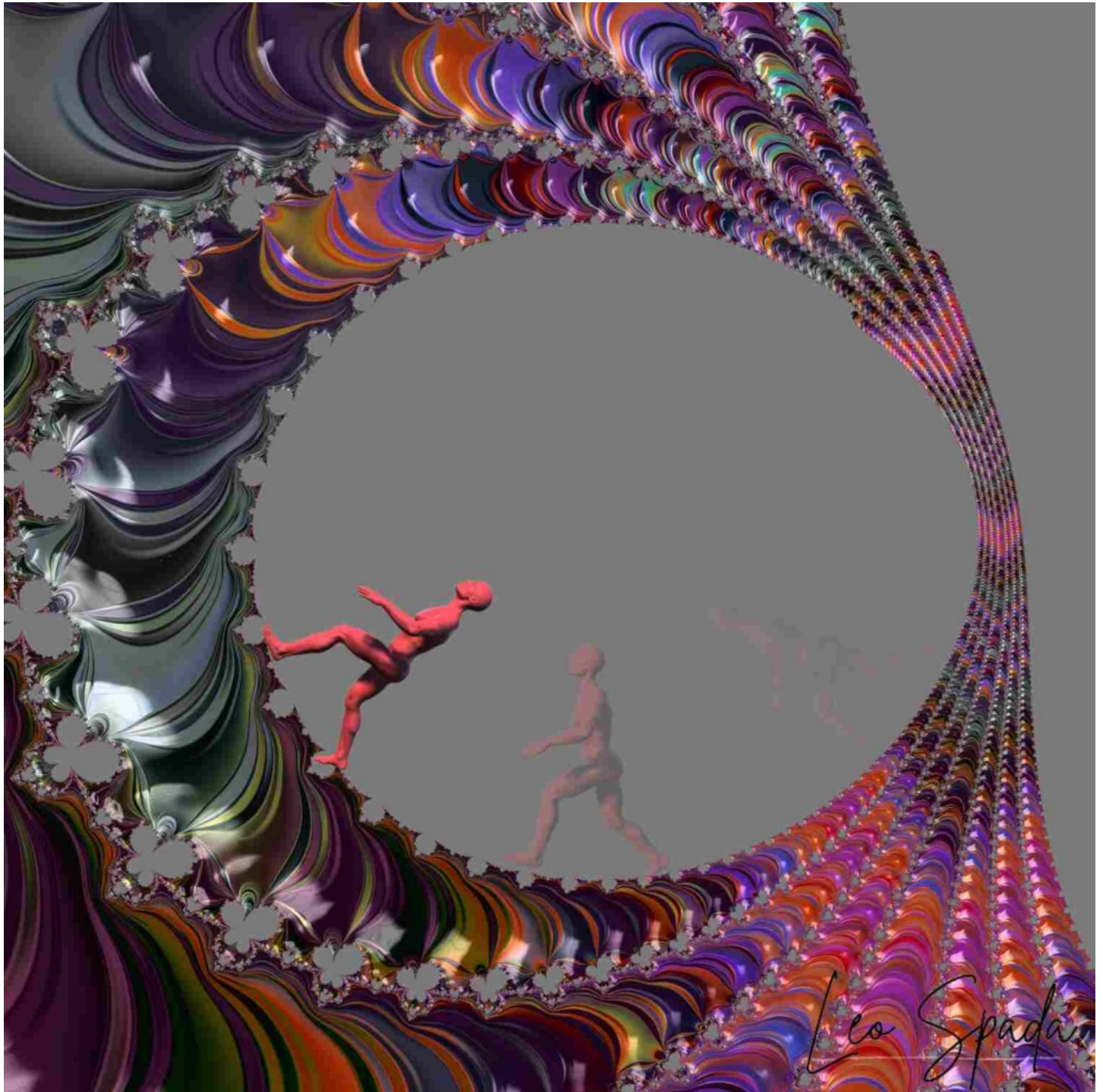


Interview with Leo Spada, digital artist

Digital Art - NFT Collection



London, United Kingdom May 14, 2022 ([Issuewire.com](https://www.issuewire.com)) - During a **conference on digital art** held in London earlier this year, we met [Leo Spada](#), an emerging Italian artist who in recent years has begun to devote himself to the digital world with great success.

We did a short interview with him that we report below.

- You have landed in the world of digital art in the recent years but you come from a past as an artist of physical works, how did you find this new world?

"It's true, I have always realized physical works, first on canvas and then using glass in all its forms. I recently discovered digital art and I immediately found myself at ease because it allowed me to use my great love for information technology and computers in art"

- In this way you confirm yourself as a very eclectic artist, don't you think that the continuous change from one technique to another can be a limit?

"I honestly do not think so: the techniques used are only a means to express my emotions and my feelings. Digital art is a very powerful means of expression and I believe it is the future of art, it allows you to create unique and eternal works of art, without the limits of any physical work"

- Your digital works are very recognizable and have as a common feature an element depicted in red immersed in a fantastic and colorful world, do you want to explain the meaning?

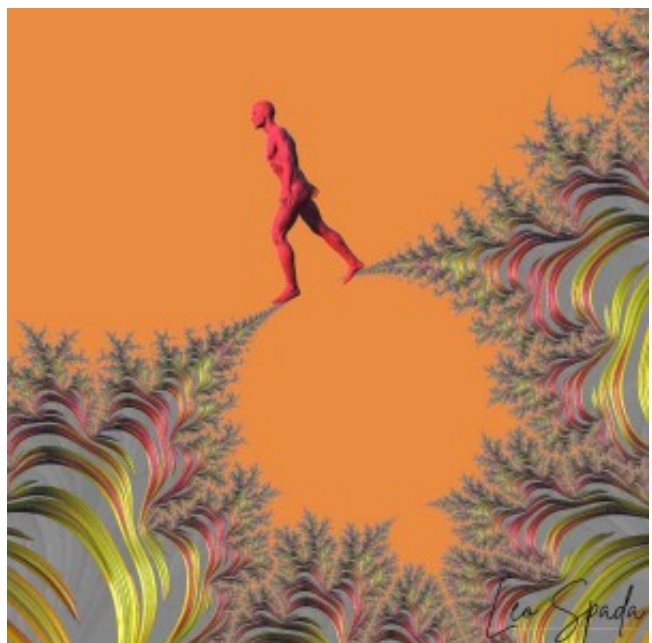
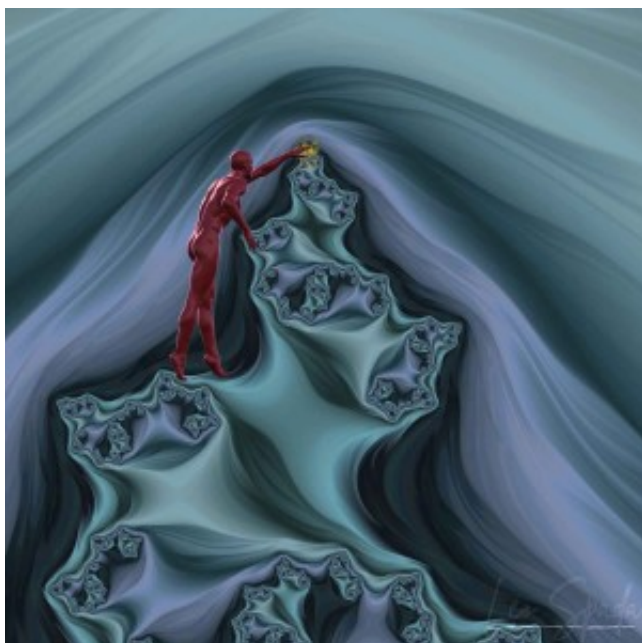
"The character in the foreground represents each of us and our reaction to the situations that life brings to us and symbolized by the fantastic world in which we find ourselves immersed"

- How do you make these fantastic worlds?

"These worlds are created through the mathematics of fractals; as in our life, it is often chance or fate that confronts us with positive or negative situations to which we must try to give an answer. Red indicates the strength of emotions and our ability to create a reaction"
