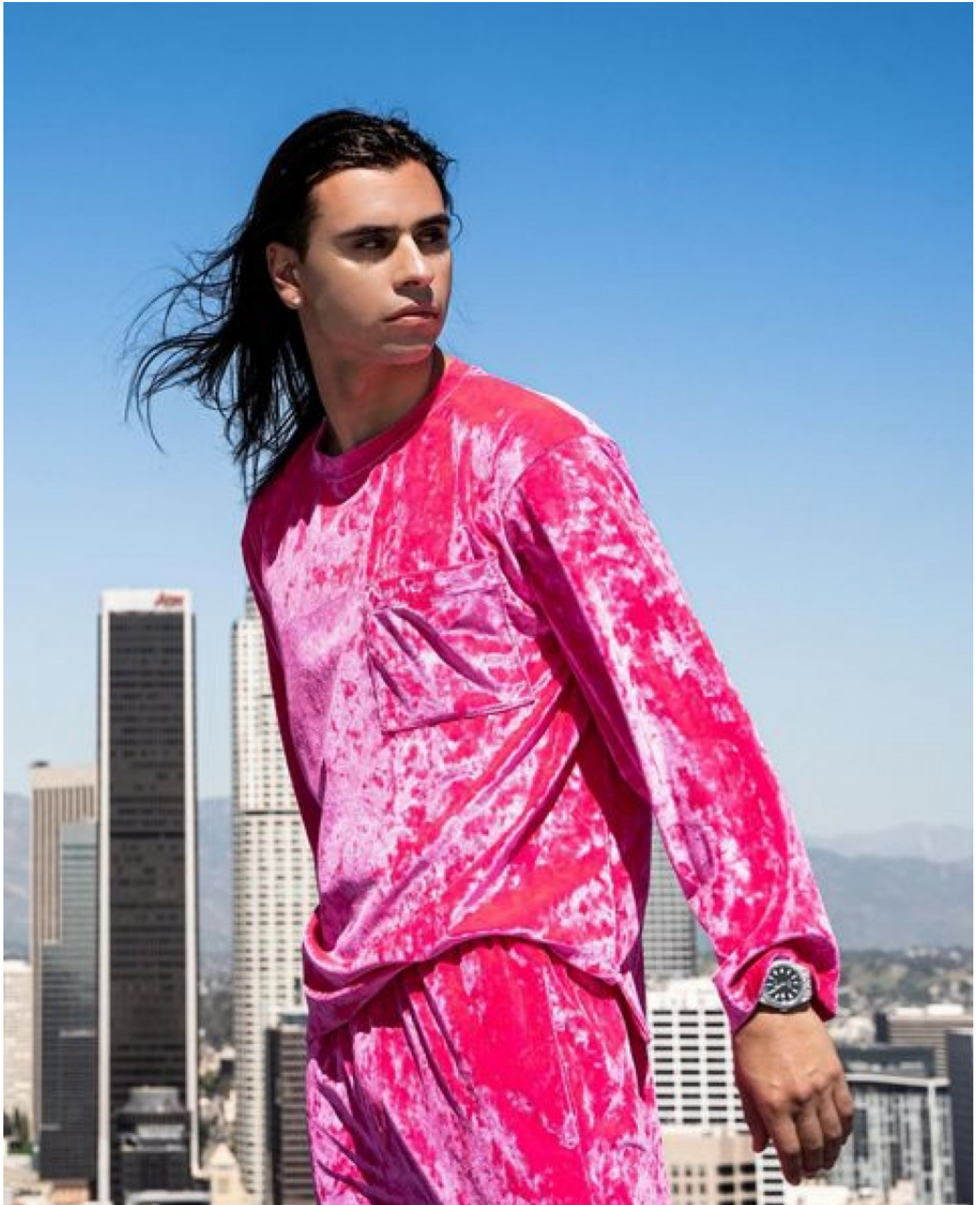


The New Song 'Fast Life' has been Released by Cyrus Dobre

Cyrus Dobre, the prolific artist has showcased his creative talent and turned all the music enthusiast's heads with his latest soundtrack 'Fast Life'.



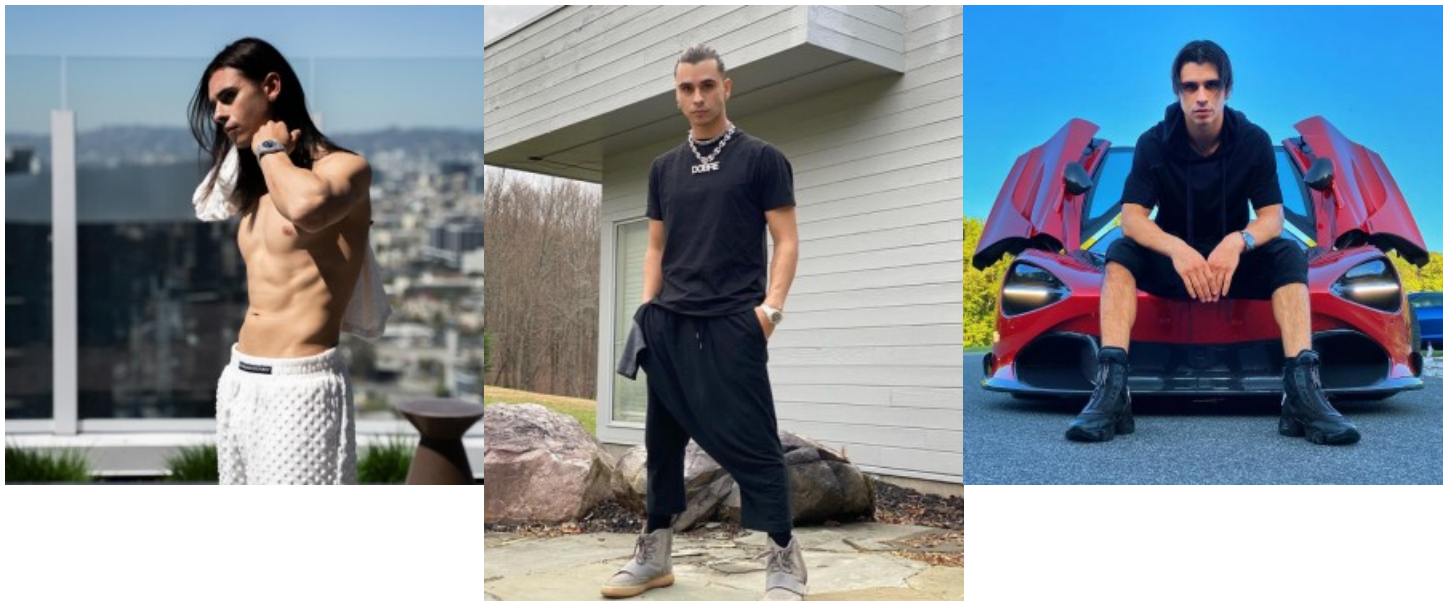
