
Vishal Kapur, MD, FACC, FSCAI, RPVI, an Interventional Cardiologist with Mount Sinai

His hard work and commitment during his fellowship training were recognized and appreciated, and he was awarded the prestigious H. Liston Beazley MD Student Clinician of the Year Award.

Subsequently, Dr. Kapur completed an additional fellowship in interventional cardiology at one of the world-renowned ivy league academic centers - Columbia University Medical Center - under Drs. Martin Leon and Greg Stone, followed by an extra year of dedicated training in peripheral/endovascular intervention at the same educational venue.

Licensed to practice medicine in New York, New Jersey, Connecticut, and Texas, the doctor is board-certified in cardiovascular disease, interventional cardiology, vascular medicine, endovascular medicine, and internal medicine by the American Board of Internal Medicine (ABIM). He is also certified in adult comprehensive echocardiography through American Registry for Diagnostic Medical Sonography (ARDMS).

A Registered Physician in Vascular Interpretation (RPVI), he is a Fellow of the American College of Cardiology (FACC), and a Fellow of the Society of Cardiovascular Angiography and Interventions (FSCAI).

Academically involved in the field, Dr. Kapur serves as an Associate Professor of Cardiology at the Mount Sinai Medical Center. He has published numerous research articles in peer-reviewed renowned medical journals, written book chapters, and presented abstracts, posters, and oral presentations, and various local, national, and international conferences. He has also been a co-investigator in many clinical trials.

Cardiology is a branch of medicine that deals with the disorders of the heart, as well as some parts of the circulatory system. The field includes medical diagnosis and treatment of congenital heart defects, coronary artery disease, heart failure, valvular heart disease, and electrophysiology. Cardiologists are doctors who diagnose, assess, and treat patients with diseases and defects of the heart and blood vessels (the cardiovascular system).
