
Jumping Jane Global Women's Empowerment Conference

I wanted this conference to give me the knowledge I wish I had when I started." Whaley I s not alone. The entire Jumping Jane panel is committed to decreasing the number of women who are stuck in low-paid jobs and have no real protection from economic injustices. They are women dedicated to seeing other women overcome enormous barriers such as unequal pay and a lack of flexible work arrangements. As Whaley says, "Women could contribute so much more to the global economy and get so much more out of it if we had a fair playing field, if our issues mattered to more people." The Jumping Jane panelists also want girls to have better opportunities and less stifling pay gaps. They want to make sure that these girls can someday increase the global workforce from 50 percent to 76 percent or more, so that women are equally represented alongside their male counterparts. Said Whaley, "The Jumping Jane Global Women's Empowerment Conference will bridge and erase the gap of disparity for women in all lines of work and circumstances. 
