Many people have to get admitted to city hospitals due to serious illnesses, and lakhs of rupees and months are spent on that. By making these polyclinics or satellite clinics eHDU, the cost and burden of the diseases can be reduced.

Sensoriom's new satellite clinic has started from Kasganj city. This clinic is built in partnership with Jain Nursing Home, located at a prominent landmark, Nadrai Gate. Many specialist doctors will visit every week to extend their specialist medical services. In addition to this satellite, the clinic will also have an eHDU, where patients with serious conditions could be treated through innovative devices and telemedicine. Here an innovative ECG device designed by Tricog Health India will also be included for quick and reliable cardiac screening and diagnosis.
