From 2010 to 2012, she worked at Advocate Christ Medical Center's NICU, Oak Lawn.

Dr. Trevino said, "My training, as well as my ability to communicate fluently in Spanish, has prepared me well to serve the diverse patient population in the area. I'm excited to have the opportunity to provide quality care to children as if they were my own. I feel privileged to soon be a big part of their families' lives."

Board-certified by the American Board of Pediatrics and a member of the American Academy of Pediatrics, Dr. Trevino is certified in Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS), Neonatal Resuscitation (NRP), and Moderate Sedation.

In the state of Illinois, she is affiliated with Rush Copley Medical Center, Northwestern Memorial Hospital, Rush University Medical Center, and Northwestern Medicine Valley West Hospital.

When Dr. Trevino reflected on her experiences that ultimately led her to choose pediatrics as her specialty, she said, "I was meant to be a pediatrician and I couldn't be happier! I'm glad I followed my heart."

Pediatrics is the branch of medicine that involves the medical care of infants, children, and adolescents. The American Academy of Pediatrics recommends individuals be under pediatric care up to the age of 21. Pediatricians provide medical care to people ranging in age from newborns to young adults. They are trained to examine, diagnose, and treat children with a wide variety of injuries and illnesses through all of their developmental stages, as they grow and mature.
