
## David S. Gidseg, MD, FACP, FACC, FCCP, FASNC, a Cardiologist with Suffolk Heart Group

Maintaining fellowship status, Dr. Gidseg is a Fellow of the American College of Physicians (FACP), a Fellow of the American College of Cardiology (FACC), Fellow of the American College of Chest Physicians (FCCP), and Fellow of the American Society of Nuclear Cardiology (FASNC).

Continuously advancing his efforts, he is an active member of the American Society of Echocardiography, the Suffolk County Medical Society, the American College of Physicians, the American College of Cardiology, the American College of Chest Physicians, the American Heart Association, the American Society of Nuclear Cardiology, and the American Medical Association. He is also certified in Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS), and Basic Life Support (BLS).
