The two often team up under their Sound Ventures partnership to invest in early-stage tech companies that have included Spotify, Airbnb, Pinterest, and Robinhood. In total, The Fabricant has raised \$14 million in funding since 2018, California Apparel News reported.

Colors the artist, inspired by the visionary idea for a digital only fashion house and its potential in the

Metaverse, penned the poem to reflect the unique journey of The Fabricant and its forward-thinking backers.
