Subsequent to his education, the doctor attained board certification in otolaryngology through the American Board of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery, which is a non-profit corporation that has set the mission of ensuring professional standards with certificates and memberships and has offered training in the fields of head neck surgery to professionals since 1924.

Remaining up to date in his field, he is an active member of the American Academy of Otolaryngology-Head & Neck Surgery and the American Academy of Facial Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery.

Among his other roles, Dr. Warman maintains hospital privileges at Flushing Hospital Medical Center, and New York Presbyterian - Queens.

Otolaryngology is the oldest medical specialty in the United States. Pediatric otolaryngologists are primarily concerned with medical and surgical treatment of ear, nose, and throat diseases in children. They generally provide the following services: diagnosis and treatment of ear, nose, and throat disorders, as well as head and neck diseases.

Among his most notable achievements, Dr. Warman has been the recipient of the Patients' Choice Award (2011, 2009, 2008).

Outside the office, he enjoys playing tennis, scuba diving, and biking. He's supportive of animal welfare causes, as well as those working to combat cancer and eating and body dysmorphic disorders.
