
Samiksha B. Bansal, MD, a Pediatric General Surgeon with Children's Healthcare of Atlanta

As for her academic appointment, she serves as a Clinical Assistant Professor of Surgery within the Division of Pediatric Surgery, Department of Surgery at the Emory University School of Medicine.

With a broad educational background, Dr. Bansal earned her MBBS at Jawaharlal Nehru Medical College in Aligarh, India. Her postgraduate training included a general surgery residency at SUNY Upstate Medical University, a postdoctoral research fellowship at Cleveland Clinic, a pediatric surgery clinical/research fellowship at Children's Hospital Colorado, a pediatric surgery advanced laparoscopic surgery fellowship at Rocky Mountain Hospital for Children in Denver, and pediatric surgery trauma and pediatric surgery clinical fellowships at Cardinal Glennon Children's Hospital in St. Louis.

The doctor is board-certified in surgery by the American Board of Surgery, an independent, non-profit organization located in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, founded for the purpose of certifying surgeons who have met a defined standard of education, training, and knowledge.

Throughout her line of work, Dr. Bansal has conducted multiple retrospective and prospective studies, with specific projects ranging from analysis of non-invasive hemodynamic monitoring during blood donation for developing models of early blood loss, to the development of a continuous, non-invasive, real-time method for estimating and predicting intracranial hypertension in children.

General surgery is a surgical specialty that focuses on the alimentary canal and abdominal contents including the esophagus, stomach, small intestine, large intestine, liver, pancreas, gallbladder, appendix and bile ducts, and often the thyroid gland. Pediatric surgeons treat children from birth through late adolescence. They choose to make pediatric care the core of their medical practice.
