Krysten Cummings (Book and Direction) in Rent originated the role of Mimi in Toronto and London, later playing the part on Broadway. She has numerous theater credits, especially in London, and has worked with Andrew Lloyd-Weber, Cameron Mackintosh, and Stephen Schwartz.

Collin Maier (Composer and Arrangements) has had productions at The Prince Theatre (It's A Wonderful Life) and The Devon Theatre (Joseph & the Amazing Technicolor Dream Coat). His extensive résumé includes working for The Walnut Street Theatre, Act II Playhouse, Temple University, and Drexel University, in addition to numerous regional theatrical productions.
