Delivery E-bike Pilot Program

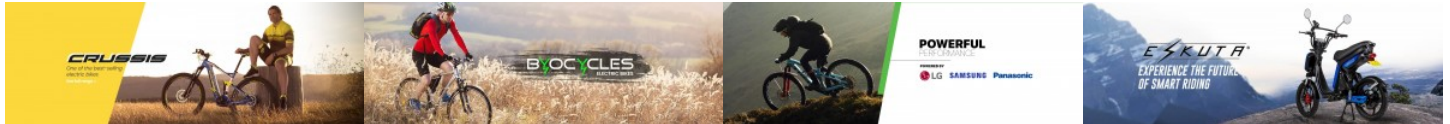
