Auli Bugyal translates to "Field of Grass" (Ghas Ka Meadan). It is 8200 feet above sea level at its highest point. The Nanda Devi, Comet, and Dunagiri hills, which appear to be quite lovely and alluring, are seen. The snow cover accumulates to a depth of three feet between January and March, giving the mountains' tops the appearance of being draped in white. From Joshimath, you may hike or take the ropeway to Auli. The distance from Joshimath to Auli is only 11–12 kilometers. This location is the greatest in terms.

CHOPTA;- Chopta is a little hamlet or town in the Rudraprayag district of Uttarakhand's Gharwal area. It is often referred to as the "Mini Switzer Land of India" and is situated 8556 feet above sea level. From Chopta, you can see Tungnath, the third Kedar temple of Panch Kedar, which is the tallest Shiva temple in the world (Five temples of Lord Shiva). Trekking from Chopta to Tungnath requires 3.5 km of flat

terrain, followed by 1.5 km of steep terrain to reach Chandrashila's top.
