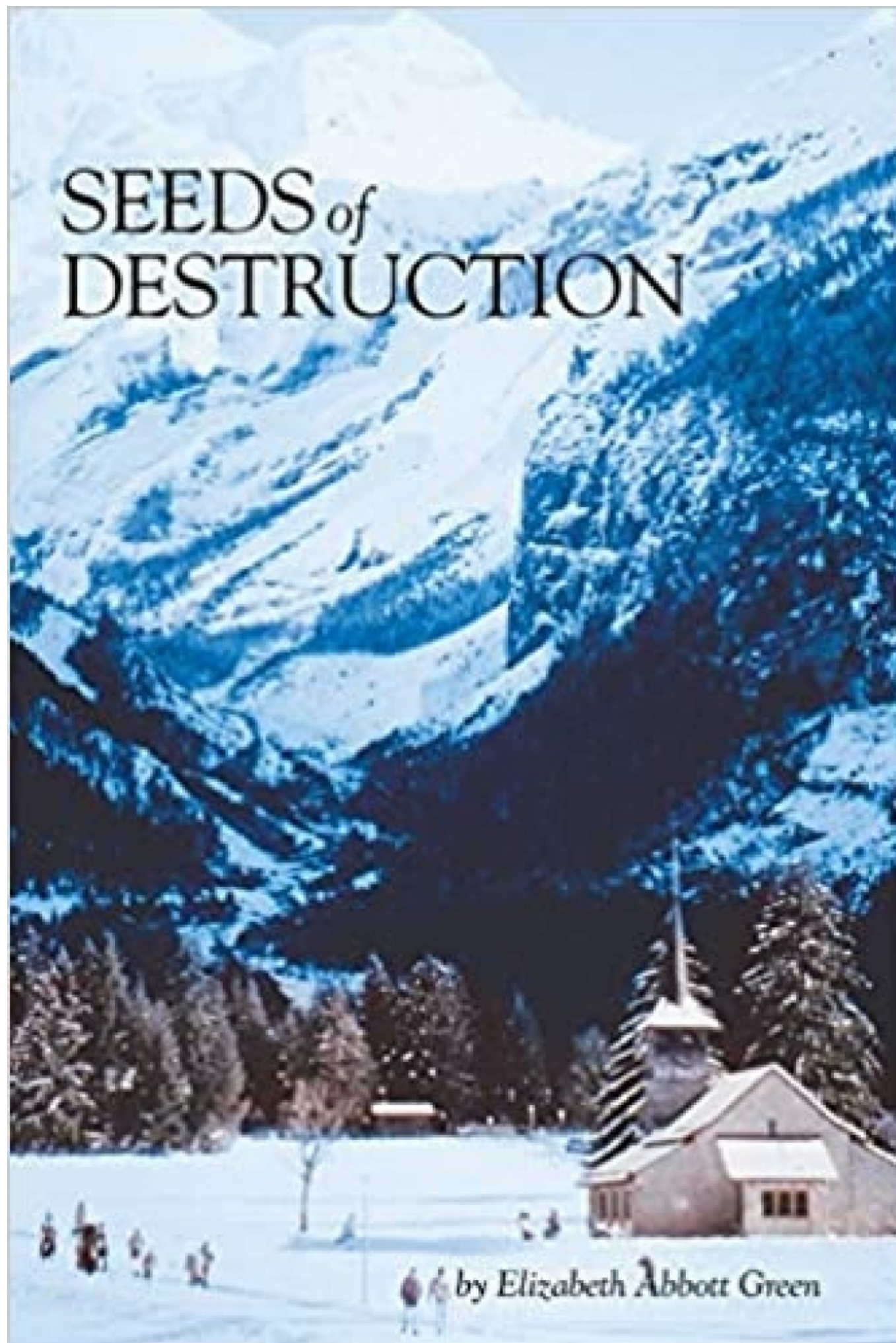


Elizabeth Abbott Green's 'Seeds of Destruction' will be seen at the 2022 Sharjah International Book Fair
