The AOBPN is an organization that provides board certification to qualified Doctors of Osteopathic Medicine (DOs) who specialize in disorders of the nervous system (neurologists) and to qualified DOs who specialize in the diagnosis and treatment of mental disorders (psychiatrists).

Holding fellowship status, Dr. Creps is a Fellow of the American College of Neuropsychiatrists (FACN) and a Fellow of the American Psychiatric Association (FAPA).

Moreover, he is a member of the Arizona Society of Addiction Medicine and the American Osteopathic Association. He is also a past secretary of the Arizona Academy of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry and the Arizona Society of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry.

A firm believer that he received the calling to be a psychiatrist at the age of sixteen years old, Dr. Creps emphasizes the importance of maintaining "knowledge of the profession-psychiatry is a continuing learning process – it never stops."

Throughout his illustrious career, he has earned extensive experience in the areas of general psychiatry, addiction, acute and chronic mental illness, and outpatient care.
