Passionate about his profession, he is board-certified in diagnostic radiology and interventional radiology by the American Board of Radiology (ABR). The ABR is a not-for-profit physician-led organization that oversees the certification and ongoing professional development of specialists in diagnostic radiology, interventional radiology, radiation oncology, and medical physics.

Among Dr. Cobb's professional affiliations include the American College of Radiology, the American Medical Association, the American Roentgen Ray Society, the International Society for the Study of Vascular Anomalies, the International Society of Thrombosis and Haemostasis, the Pennsylvania Radiological Society, the Philadelphia Angiography and Interventional Radiology Society, the Philadelphia Roentgen Ray Society, and the Society of Interventional Radiology.

His areas of research include post-thrombotic syndrome, chronic DVT, chronic venous disease, and MR lymphangiography.

Interventional radiology is a medical specialty that performs various minimally-invasive procedures using medical imaging guidance, such as x-ray fluoroscopy, computed tomography, magnetic resonance imaging, or ultrasound. Interventional radiologists diagnose and treat disease. They treat a wide range of conditions in the body by inserting various small tools, such as catheters or wires from outside the body.
