
3 Most Common Types of Dental Implants for Adults at Confident Smile Dentistry

These are the 3 Most Common Types of Dental Implants for Adults at Confident Smile Dentistry:

Single Tooth Implant

Single-tooth implants are used to replace a missing tooth. They're great for filling a gap in your smile and preventing adjacent teeth from shifting into the space. Tooth implants will also act as fixtures permanently rooted to the patient's jawbone. A pontic tooth is then attached to it before a crown is fitted.

Implant-Supported Bridge

An implant-supported bridge takes advantage of the stability of a <u>dental implant in Pinellas Park</u> to hold the dental bridge in place. They're highly popular teeth replacements due to their natural look and

functionality. Implant-supported bridges are also safer as they help preserve the jawbone and are less hassle since they're not removable and won't have to be cleaned like dentures. In any case, an implant-supported bridge is a good option if you've been considering getting a traditional dental bridge but prefer a long-term fix.

All-on-4 Dental Implants

Patients with multiple missing teeth can choose All-on-4 dental implants since they're typically used to replace a full set of teeth. The procedure involves the use of multiple dental implants which securely hold the pontic teeth in place. They're also a great long-term solution since they have been known to last over two decades with the proper care. All-on-four 4 dental implants restore functionality to the patient's bite and blend in well with the surrounding natural teeth. The use of dental implants to hold the false teeth in place means that it's solidly anchored, and patients won't have to compromise on their favorite foods.
