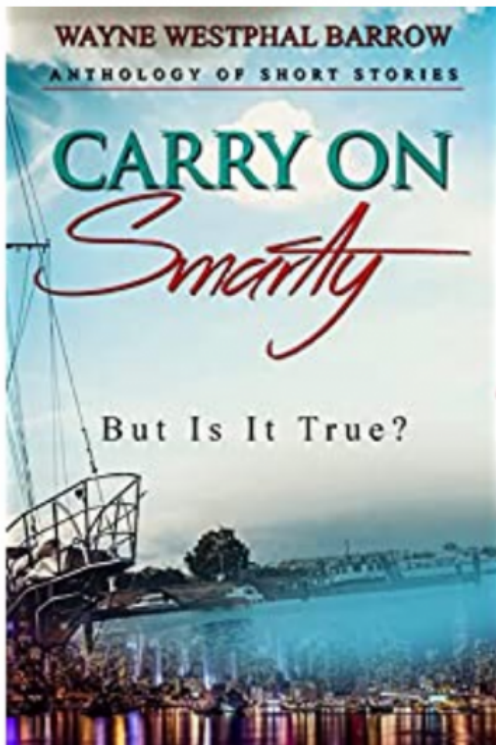


## Author's new book receives a warm literary welcome

Like the story of the tradesman and his paramour; like the plane ride that almost ended in tragedy, the author addresses multiple concepts of life: justice, spirituality, power, ethics, and, basically what it means to be alive and live amongst other humans. The stories might be true; they might be fantasy. There's always an element of truth in a work of fiction. Like a work of art depicts what the artist sees and feels, these stories depict the inner workings of a creative mind, raw and blunt, actively seeking meaning in a complex world. Set in various Caribbean countries, the stories are engaging, and entertaining, and draw the reader in with ease, allowing the reader to contemplate the morals and topics presented.
