Who sells smart locks?

What's wrong with hiding a key?

Everyone has done this. Some people still do. It's tempting, after all, to think that you can outsmart the bad guys and hide a key somewhere. Some people even just get complacent about it—they may think, "let them go ahead and get into my house. There's nothing to steal."

The reality is that thieves can find more than you think, and even if they don't, the violation of their being in your home is difficult enough for most. Don't hide keys in obvious spots, at the very least. You don't want to just hand it to people. Try to hide keys somewhere only family members can access (i.e., a garage or shed) or leave them with a neighbor for backup.

Some people even get tempted to leave their doors unlocked so that they don't need a key. It's inconspicuous enough to leave that side door unlocked, right? It's not like anyone will know. At least, you hope they won't. But what you're not thinking about is how many people break into homes simply by checking the doors to see if they're open.

If you leave even one door or window unlocked, you're inviting danger. And, it's also going to make it more difficult for you to prove to break and entering to the insurance company when there's not any "breaking".

Do locksmiths help with regular lock services?
