Christian Zellner, MD, an Interventional Cardiologist with HCA Florida Heart Institute - Bradenton & HCA Florida Blake Hospital



New York City, New York Dec 15, 2022 ([Issuewire.com](https://www.issuewire.com)) - Named a 2022 Top Doctor by Sarasota Magazine, Dr. Zellner practices preventative and interventional cardiology at HCA Florida Heart Institute - Bradenton. He is also affiliated with HCA Florida Blake Hospital.

Some of the procedures that he performs / conditions that he treats include cardiac arrhythmia and conduction disorders, cardiology, coronary atherosclerosis, and other heart diseases, as well as peripheral arterial disease rehabilitation.

Educated in Germany, Dr. Zellner graduated with his medical degree from the Ludwig Maximilian University of Munich in 1994. After moving to California, he completed his residency in internal medicine at St. Mary Medical Center, and two fellowships in cardiovascular disease and interventional cardiology at UCSF Medical Center.

Prior to moving to Bradenton, he was a partner at a large multi-specialty group in the Midwest, in Springfield, Illinois where he established a Radial Access Catheterization as well as a Heart Valve and Structural Heart Disease Program.

A principal investigator in heart failure and cardiovascular genetic studies, Dr. Zellner is board-certified in cardiovascular disease and interventional cardiology by the American Board of Internal Medicine (ABIM). The ABIM is a physician-led, non-profit, independent evaluation organization driven by doctors who want to achieve higher standards for better care in a rapidly changing world.

Furthermore, he holds board certifications in nuclear cardiology through the Certification Board of Nuclear Cardiology, and in echocardiography through the National Board of Echocardiography.

Interventional cardiology is a non-surgical option that uses a small, flexible tube called a catheter to repair damaged or weakened vessels, narrowed arteries, or other affected parts of the heart structure. An interventional cardiologist is a cardiologist with one to two years of additional education and training in diagnosing and treating cardiovascular disease as well as congenital (present at birth) and structural heart conditions through catheter-based procedures, such as angioplasty and stenting.

Recognized for his academic and clinical work, Dr. Zellner received prestigious Fellowship Awards from the American Heart Association and the Heart Failure Society of America. His dedication to clinical cardiology and teaching was recognized by the UCSF House Staff Stethoscope Award.

Among his other accolades include the Patients' Choice Award (2018), On-Time Doctor Award (2018), and Compassionate Doctor Recognition (2018).

On a more personal note, he is fluent in both English and German.
