It is estimated that the average disposable diaper takes up to 500 years to degrade.

By switching to more environmentally conscious choices like cotton langot, cloth diapers, and diaper pants you can reduce your landfill contributions as well as your baby's carbon footprint.

Newborn baby langots, unlike other disposable items, are extremely adorable because they come in a variety of print options that you simply cannot resist on your baby. And wearing these with regular winter clothing will make your child look adorable.

So because a baby may pee or poop during this time, you must take extreme caution. To keep your bed/sofa clean, place a waterproof stay-dry sheet beneath the baby.

Dry feel Langot is made up of 100% 3-layer cotton padding with gentle elastics which makes it able to absorb up to 1 pee and is extremely comfortable.
