As a result of his experiences as a medical student and a graduate student, he developed an immense passion for teaching, receiving the Fellow of the Year Award. He has been on the faculty of several medical schools, giving hematology lectures and mentoring medical students. He believes that teaching patients and their families are the most important thing a doctor can do.

Hematology is the branch of medicine concerned with the treatment and prevention of diseases related to blood, including clotting, bleeding, anemia, iron deficiency, and less common blood disorders.
