
## The Trading Bible.com launches the Broker Database, a new tool designed to help traders find the right broker


The broker database operates on both mobile and desktop devices and showcases information using a horizontal layout where critical data points will be displayed numerically or using a yes/no format.

All of TheTradingBible.com's tools include critical information such as the **licence panel**, a tool designed to give users a quick overview of the regulatory status of a brokerage firm. When the "regulated" rectangle has a green background, it means that the broker holds at least one top-tier

financial licence (as per our criteria). When the square has a grey background and also reads the text "regulated" it means that the broker is regulated but it doesn't count on a top-tier licence.
