

Antipodean Johor Bahru opens in Malaysia

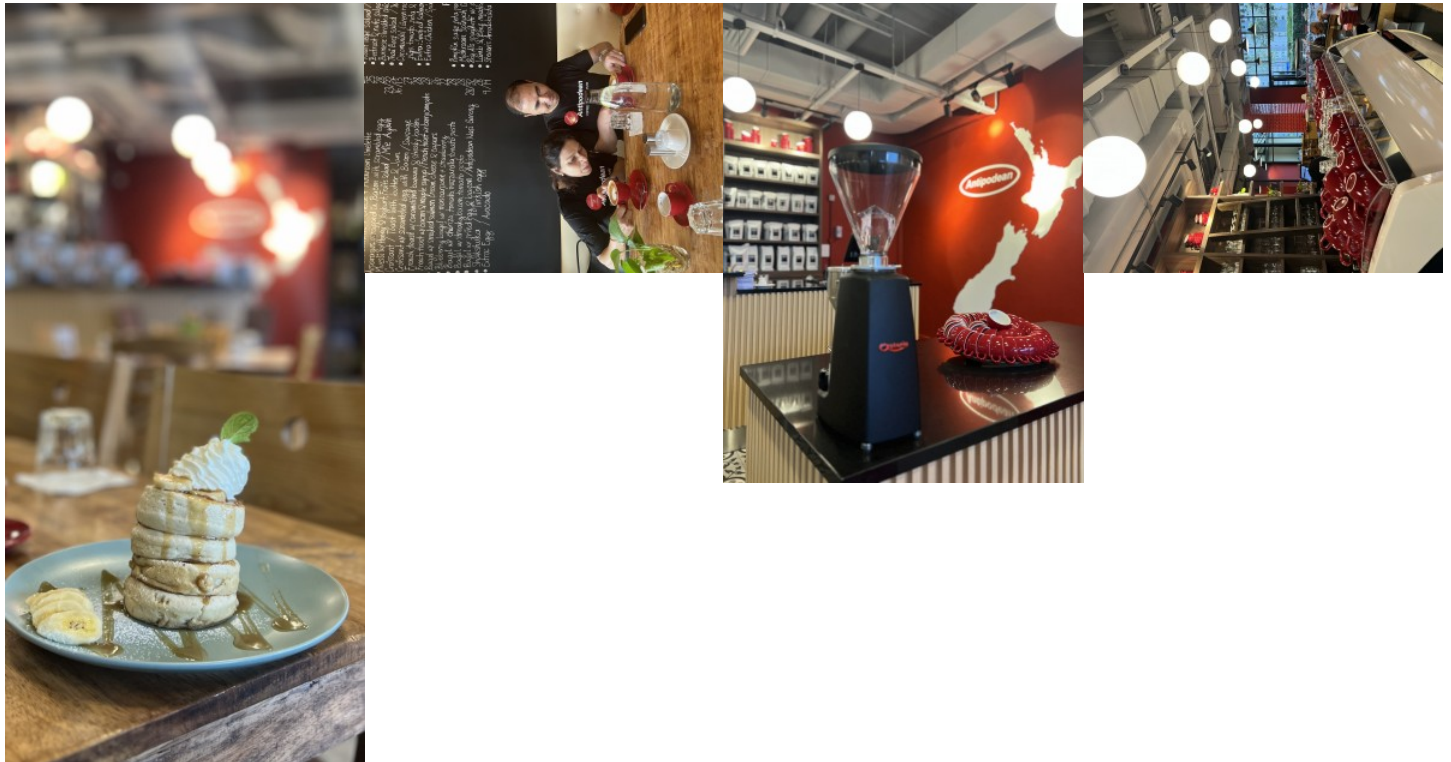
