
Bryan Darby Explores a Variety of Human Emotions in the Relaunch of His Compelling Anthology of Short Stories

Moving from southeast London to Kent in 1962, Bryan Darby's interest in writing was aroused when he met Peggy Cochrane, the well-known concert pianist and composer and wife of 1930- 40s bandleader, Jack Payne.
