His faculty association was with both the Division of Endocrinology and the Division of Arteriosclerosis and Lipid Metabolism.

Among his professional affiliations, he is an active member of the American Association of Clinical Endocrinologists, the American Diabetes Association, the American Heart Association, and the National Lipid Association.
