Yemi opens up to God's presence, and receives it wholeheartedly, noticeably felt in the music with intentional key changes and additional instrumentation. Beautiful saxophone lines complement Yemi's acceptance and journey to God's comfort by the end.

When asked what being found as expressed in this passionate song means, Yemi's responses were;

Today, our world has been taken over by the 'celebrity' mentality and the need or craving for becoming 'FAMOUS'. The need to monetize all our experiences, whether divine or mortal has become the game of thrones. We must refuse to monetize God and our worship, Yemi said.

We need to trust God in this current economic climate and be assured that He will meet all our needs according to His riches in glory. We must tell others to do the same. We cannot sell salvation; it's already paid for. It is therefore not that we love God but that He first loved us.

"God's love is the answer to all what we may be looking for. The person of Jesus is enough for me," Yemi says.
