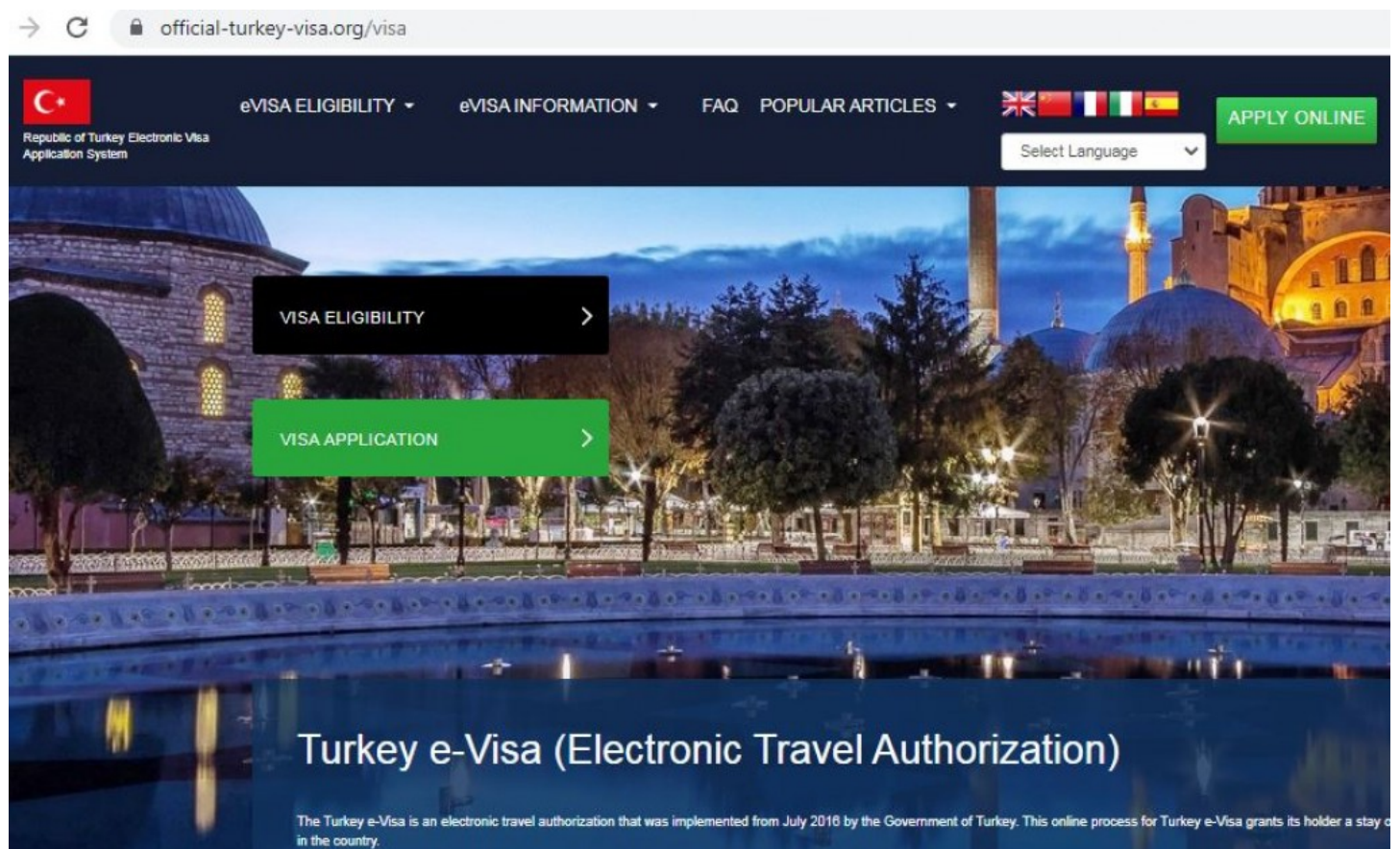


Enjoy the Picturesque Retreats of Turkey with the Turkey eVisas for Emirati and Indian Citizens



Istanbul, Turkey Feb 2, 2023 (Issuewire.com) - Awe-inspiring natural beauty, wide arrays of savory delicacies along with the rich historic and cultural heritage of the land make Turkey one of the most popular tourist destinations in the world. The Tourism Strategy of Turkey 2023, keeping in mind the objectives of the 9th Development Scheme, aims to improve the management of tourism sectors on a regional basis leading to a greater traveling experience for tourists.

However, foreign nationalists traveling to Turkey would require a mandatory Visa. Tourists can now apply for **Turkey Visa Online**, which is an electronic travel authorization that has been implemented by the Turkish Government since July 2016, permitting tourists to stay in the country for up to 3 months. The procedures for **Turkey Visa Application** include three steps, which allow people from more than 50 countries to apply for it in a short time frame, and that too from the comfort of their homes. Though most applications are processed within 24 hours, it is advisable to apply for the eVisa at least 72 hours before entering the country or boarding the flight. While the online Turkey Tourist Visa is a much more convenient method for tourists traveling to the country, some countries like Georgia, Ukraine, Macedonia, and Kosovo are exempt from this facility

The electronic **Turkey Visa for Emirati Citizens** allows the holders to visit the country for short tourism, medical purposes, business, and transit visits of up to 90 days. The passport of the eVisa holders must be valid for at least 6 months beyond the date of departure. Being a launch member of the Turkey eVisa program, Indians can also apply for the **Turkey Visa for Indian Citizens** online. The only criteria for completing the procedure are to have an email Id, a Credit / Debit card in 1 of the 133 currencies, or Paypal.
