
Luke Edgecombe, MD, a General Surgeon with White River Health Surgical Clinic & White River Medical Center

A general surgeon performs a wide range of abdominal surgeries for many forms of intestinal and abdominal wall neoplasms, gallbladder disease, and gastric and pancreatic disease. They follow the patient through critical care and surgical recovery all the way to outpatient care.
