Distinguished as a Fellow of the American Association of Neurological Surgeons (FAANS), the doctor is board-certified in neurosurgery by the American Board of Neurological Surgery (ABNS). The broad aim of the ABNS is to encourage the study, improve the practice, elevate the standards, advance the science of neurological surgery, and thereby serve the cause of public health.

Among his other roles, he played a key role in the development of the Methodist Sugar Land Spine Center and served as Director of the program from 2009-2013. As the demand for expanded neuroscience service lines grew in Fort Bend County, he was a key leader in the formation of the Methodist Sugar Land Neuroscience Program and served as the Surgical Director from 2013-2017. He also served as President and Vice-President of the Fort Bend Medical Society.

With a passion for teaching, Dr. Bindal holds an academic appointment as a Clinical Assistant Professor of Neurosurgery at Baylor College of Medicine.

Neurosurgery is the medical specialty concerned with the prevention, diagnosis, surgical treatment, and rehabilitation of disorders that affect any portion of the nervous system including the brain, spinal cord, peripheral nerves, and extra-cranial cerebrovascular system. Neurosurgeons are doctors who diagnose and treat problems with the nervous system, often by performing surgery on the brain or spine. They treat strokes, tumors, cervical and lumbar disc disease, infections, and head or spinal cord injuries.

As a testament to his dedication to providing exceptional care and service to his patients, Dr. Bindal has been the recipient of the Physician of the Quarter Award by Methodist Sugar Land Hospital, Leading Physician, Most Technologically Innovative by Methodist Sugar Land Hospital, Compassionate Doctor Recognition (2020, 2018, 2017, 2016, 2015, 2010), Patients' Choice Award (2020, 2018, 2017, 2016, 2015), On-Time Doctor Award (2020, 2018, 2016, 2015), Patients' Choice 5th Anniversary Award (2020), and Compassionate Doctor Award - 5 Year Honoree (2020).
