Botox is a protein that relaxes muscles. It's injected into the skin to temporarily halt the movement of those muscles, smoothing out wrinkles and lines in the process. The results usually last for 3-4 months before another injection is needed.

Botox can cause some side effects, including pain, redness, and swelling at injection sites; flu-like symptoms such as fever and chills; headaches; dizziness; muscle weakness (for example, eyelid drooping); drooping of facial muscles near treated areas; excessive sweating or salivation near treated

areas; difficulty swallowing; tiredness or weakness (rare). These side effects generally go away on their own within 2 weeks after treatment ends

Results last three to four months.

The effects of Botox will last anywhere from three to four months, depending on the amount you get, how your body responds to it, and how much you move your face. If you have a lot of wrinkles or frown lines and want them gone for good, then regular injections are for you.

Botox can cause some minor side effects, like bruising and soreness at the injection site.

The most common side effect is a headache that can last up to several days after getting Botox. Soreness at the injection site is also common, but it usually goes away within a few days. If you're having muscle weakness or problems with your eyesight after getting Botox, tell your doctor right away so they can fix it.
