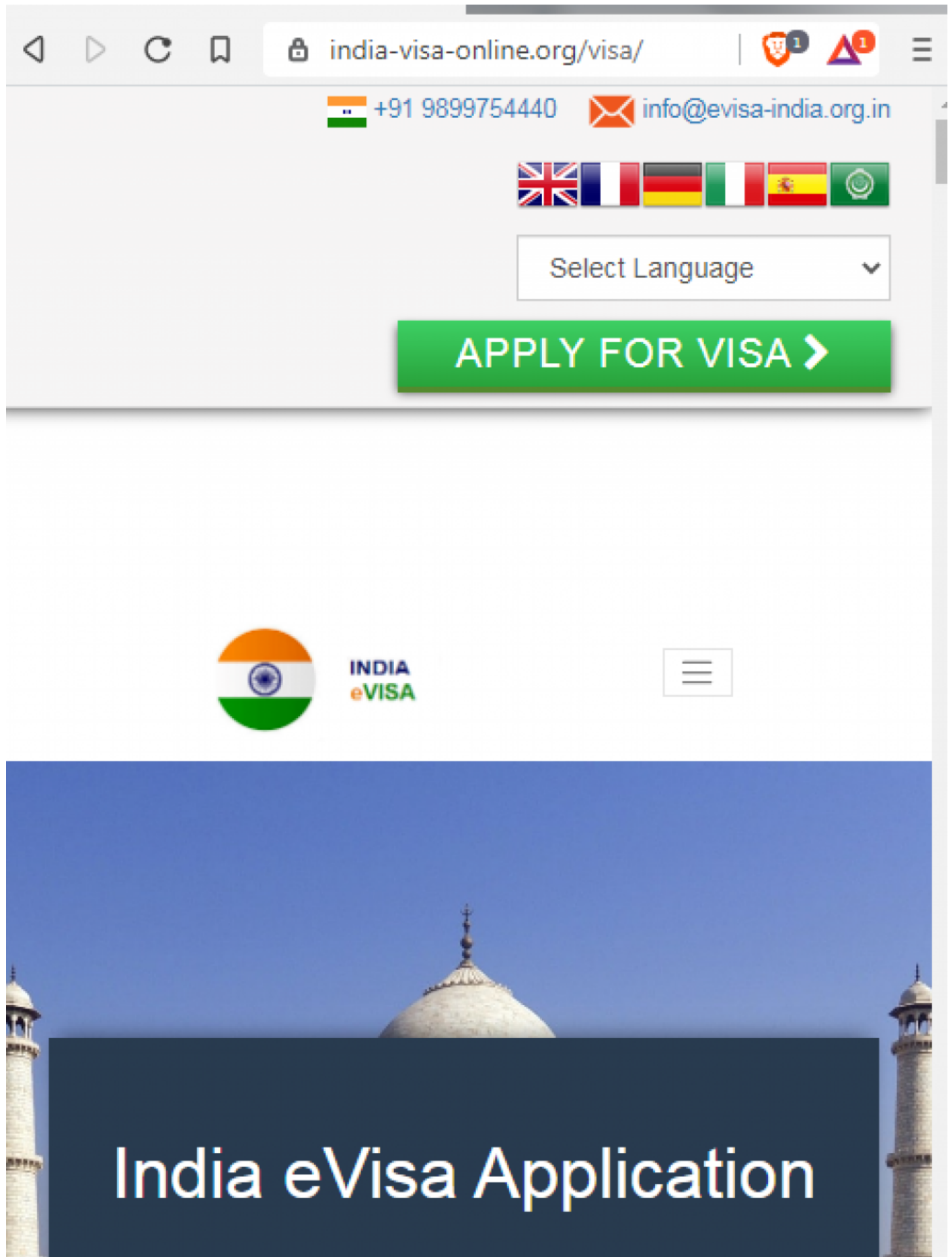


Traveling to India for Business, Medical, Emergency or Recreational Purposes Made Easier with eVisas



New Delhi, Delhi Feb 23, 2023 (IssueWire.com) - In anticipation of the massive G-20 meet of 2023, the country has launched the “Visit India 2023” campaign to ramp up the tourism sector. Be it for business, medical reasons, or recreational travel, the country has become one of the hotspots for foreign tourists, as the process of obtaining an online Visa or eVisa has never been easier.

Initially launched in 2014, the online **Business Visa for India** allows citizens from all eligible nations to visit the country for several business-related reasons hassle-free without visiting the Indian Embassy or consulate and obtaining a paper Visa. However, 15 of the 180 countries have been made temporarily ineligible due to security purposes. The online **Medical Visa for India** is a mode of electronic travel authorization that allows foreign nationals to visit India to seek medical help or treatment. The short-term Visa is valid for visits up to 60 days after entering the country, and they may enter only through government-authorized Immigration Check Posts. Often patients might not be in a condition to travel alone and require the help of a medical attendant. In that case, the person must apply for an **Indian Medical Attendant Visa** or the e-Medical Attendant visa. Only 2 medical attendants' eVisa is issued along with a medical visa, which means only two people who have already procured their Visas can travel with the patient to the country. The **5 year Indian Visa**, initiated by the government in September 2019, allows foreign nationals to visit the country for 90 days per trip for 5 years. They are allowed to visit for a maximum of 180 days a year. The 5-Year Indian Tourist Visa should be applied at least 7 days before the day of the flight and the processing time usually takes 3-5 working days. For foreigners who need to visit the country for emergency reasons like the death or illness of a family member or a loved one, or to make a legal appearance, they can apply for an **Urgent Emergency Indian Visa** online which is usually issued within 3 days.
