Its mission is to give students the opportunity to obtain an education that they may not otherwise be able to afford and to reward them for their academic excellence, impeccable moral conduct, and athletic abilities. The program is geared toward minority students, allowing them the experience the vast programming and opportunities at YHC, while creating a more diverse community at the school. The overall goal is for the scholarship to affect 4 students by 2023 and 44 students by 2033. \$20,000 will be awarded to each student recipient. This totals nearly a million dollars, which is truly groundbreaking.
