Online Doctors do not provide sick notes to school children or minors for missing school, exams, or any other class or curriculum. In Ireland, children aged up to 7 are entitled to free GP visits with the use of a medical card or GP visit card. Children must visit the GP in person, and undergo a physical examination to issue a medical certificate.
