Neurocritical care medicine focuses on the diagnosis and treatment of life-threatening diseases of the nervous system, including brain and spinal cord trauma, cerebral edema, ruptured aneurysms, severe strokes, encephalitis and meningitis, refractory seizures, complicated brain tumors. A neurocritical care physician, or neurointensivist, treats patients with neurological disorders or traumatic brain injuries.
